Word Origin:

late Middle English: from Latin **fabricat-** ‘**manufactured**’, from the verb **fabricare**, from **fabrica** ‘**something skilfully produced**’, from **faber** ‘**worker in metal, stone, etc.**’.

Example Bank:

- The prisoners claimed their confessions had been fabricated by police.
- These specialized chips will be fabricated by Mykrocorp Inc.

Fabricate is used mainly in writing, for example in journalism and legal contexts. In everyday English, people usually say **make** something up:

- They accused him of making the whole thing up.

The discs are expensive to fabricate.
