Word Origin:

early 17th cent.: from Urdu and Persian *šāl*, probably from *Shāliāt*, the name of a town in India.

- Ruth draped a shawl over her shoulders.
- She pulled her shawl about her protectively.
- She was wearing a shawl tied around her waist.
