student • a person who is studying in a school, especially an older child: ▫ Students are required to be in school by 8.30. ◇ ▫ Any high school student could tell you the answer.**pupil** • (*BrE*) a person who is being taught, especially a child in a school: ▫ The school has over 850 pupils.**Pupil** is used only in British English and is starting to become old-fashioned. **Student** is often preferred, especially by teachers and other people involved in education, and especially when talking about older children.**schoolboy/** • **schoolgirl/** • **schoolchild** • a boy, girl or child who attends school: ▫ Since she was a schoolgirl she had dreamed of going on the stage.

These words emphasize the age of the children or this period in their lives; they are less often used to talk about teaching and learning: an able schoolboy/schoolgirl/schoolchild
