Word Origin:

late 16th cent.: via Latin from Greek **thēsauros** 'storehouse, treasure'. The original sense 'dictionary or encyclopedia' was narrowed to the current meaning by the publication of Roget's Thesaurus of English Words and Phrases (1852).
