(of a plan, machine, method, etc.) very well designed and easy to use so that it cannot fail and you cannot use it wrongly

Syn: infallible

- This recipe is foolproof— it works every time.
- No system can ever be completely foolproof

Example Bank:

- The system is virtually foolproof
- We're trying to work out a way to make the system foolproof
