 1. **[uncountable and countable]** the destruction of a ship in an accident:
 - survivors of the shipwreck
 - narrowly escaping shipwreck
 2. **[countable]** a ship that has been destroyed in an accident **SYN wreck**
- II. **shipwreck** ² *BrE* ^u *AmE* ^u **verb**
be shipwrecked if someone is shipwrecked, they are in a boat or ship when it is destroyed in an accident:
 - Beatty was shipwrecked off the coast of Africa.
