- **particularly/especially suitable** The resort is particularly suitable for families.
- **equally suitable** I wanted a shoe that was equally suitable for both racing and training.
- **perfectly suitable** (=completely suitable) The programme is perfectly suitable for children of all ages.

- **right** completely suitable in every way: It's a nice house, but it isn't right for us. | We'll tell her when the time is right.
- **appropriate** suitable for a particular purpose. **Appropriate** is more formal than **suitable**: She filled out all the appropriate forms. | It may not be an appropriate time to ask him about it. | It's not appropriate to wear a short skirt for an interview. | the appropriate way to end a business letter
- **proper** the proper tool, piece of equipment, or way of doing something is the one that most people think is most suitable: You can't change a wheel without the proper tools. | the proper procedure for hiring staff
