**adverb**

often used at the end of negative sentences and at the end of questions, to mean 'any longer'

- She doesn't live here any more.
- Why doesn't he speak to me any more?
- Now she won't have to go out to work any more. Do not use 'no more' with this meaning: She doesn't live here no more.
