These words all mean to think about, study or describe sb/sth carefully, especially in order to understand them, form an opinion of them or make a decision about them.

examine • to think about, study or describe an idea, subject or piece of work very carefully: ▫ These ideas will be examined in more detail in Chapter 10.

analyse/analyze • to examine the nature or structure of sth, especially by separating it into its parts, in order to understand or explain it: ▫ The job involves gathering and analysing data. ◊ ▫ He tried to analyse his feelings.

review • to examine sth again, especially so that you can decide if it is necessary to make changes: ▫ The government will review the situation later in the year.

study • to examine sb/sth in order to understand them or it: ▫ We will study the report carefully before making a decision.

examine or study?

You **examine** sth in order to understand it or to help other people understand it, for example by describing it in a book; you **study** sth in order to understand it yourself.

discuss • to write or talk about sth in detail, showing the different ideas and opinions about it: ▫ This topic will be discussed at greater length in the next chapter.

to examine/analyse/reviewstudy/discuss **what/how/whether...**

to examine/analyse/reviewstudy/discuss the **situation/evidence**

to examine/analyse/reviewstudy/discuss sth **carefully/critically/systematically/briefly**
