to lean heavily upon smb. - тяжело опереться на кого-л.

to press heavily - сильно давить /нажимать/

to fall heavily - тяжело рухнуть /упасть/, грузно опуститься

to sigh heavily - тяжело вздохнуть

to complain heavily - горько сетовать /жаловаться/

heavily wooded - густо поросший лесом

heavily populated areas - густонаселённые районы

heavily veiled - под густой вуалью

heavily underlined - подчёркнутый жирной чертой

heavily travelled line - *ж.-д.* дорога с интенсивным движениемheavily armed - *воен.* сильно вооружённый, с мощным вооружениемheavily held - *воен.* обороняемый крупными силамиheavily reinforced - *воен.* получивший большие подкрепленияheavily committed - *воен.* ведущий напряжённый бойto suffer heavily - сильно пострадать, понести большие потери (*часто о материальном ущербе*)

to be punished [fined] heavily - понести суровое наказание [заплатить большой штраф]

to sleep heavily - спать глубоким /крепким/ сном

to lose heavily - много проигрывать

to drink heavily - сильно пить, пьянствовать

to attack heavily - *воен.* атаковать крупными силами

- He sighed heavily.

## 6. in a way that makes you feel uncomfortable or anxious

- Silence hung heavily in the room.
- The burden of guilt weighed heavily on his mind.

- a heavily loaded van
- The car was heavily laden on the way home.

" Breathing heavily, I stopped and sat down to rest.

4. **heavily built** having a large broad body that looks strong

5. if you do or say something heavily, you do it slowly and with a lot of effort, especially because you are sad or bored:

" He was walking heavily, his head down.

" Emily sighed heavily.

" 'I suppose so,' she said heavily.

6. **be heavily into something** *informal* to do something a lot or be very interested in it:

" Sid was heavily into drugs by the time he left school.
