 a member of the people and cultural community whose traditional religion is Judaism and who come from the ancient Hebrew people of Israel; a person who believes in and practises Judaism

Word Origin:
 Middle English: from Old French *juiu*, via Latin from Greek *loudaios*, via Aramaic from Hebrew *yəhūdāʾī*, from *yəhūdāʾāh* 'Judah'.
