2. **intransitive** ~ (to sth) to pay money regularly to be a member of an organization or to support a charity
 - He subscribes regularly to Amnesty International.
3. **intransitive** ~ (for sth) (finance) to apply to buy shares in a company

4. **transitive, usually passive** ~ sth to apply to take part in an activity, use a service, etc
 - The tour of Edinburgh is fully subscribed.
