1. **uncountable** the act or process of putting people or things into a group or class (= of **classifying** them)
 • a style of music that defies classification (= is like no other)
2. **countable** a group, class, division, etc. into which sb or sth is put
3. **uncountable (biology)** the act of putting animals, plants, etc. into groups, classes or divisions according to their characteristics
 • The classification of bony fish is extremely complicated.
4. **countable (technical)** a system of arranging books, tapes, magazines, etc. in a library into groups according to their subject

- a style of dancing that defies classification
- the broad classification of music into classical and pop
- Many fairly common human behaviours can fall under the general classification of 'mental illness'.
- The classification 'science' covers a great many different subjects.
