look at this garden of ours - посмотрите на наш сад

2) эллиптически вместо сочетания *our* с существительным, часто уже употреблённым в данном предложении наш, свой, наша, своя *и т. п.*

don't stay at their house, stay at ours - не останавливайтесь у них, (лучше) остановитесь у нас

it is not ours to blame him - не нам его обвинять
