  - Knead the dough on a floured surface.

Word Origin:Old English *dæg*, of Germanic origin; related to Dutch *deeg* and German *Teig*, from an Indo-European root meaning 'smear, knead'.Example Bank:

- Leave the dough to rise.
- Turn the dough out onto a lightly floured surface.
