usually before noun (approving)

having or showing an understanding of people's needs, a situation, etc. that is not based on old-fashioned attitudes and ↑prejudice

- enlightened opinions/attitudes/ideas
- an enlightened approach to teaching

Example Bank:

- More enlightened companies provided education for the workforce.
- My mother had more enlightened opinions than my father.
- We should take a more enlightened approach to young prisoners.
