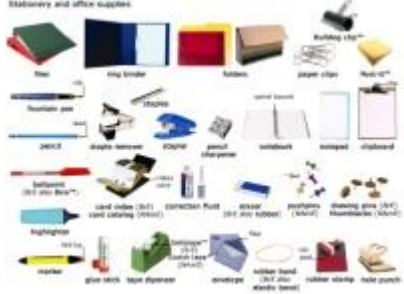

1. **countable** an object or a sign that shows the position of sth
 - a boundary marker
 - He placed a marker where the ball had landed.
 2. **singular a ~ (of/for sth)** a sign that sth exists or that shows what it is like
 - Price is not always an accurate marker of quality.
 - Peter has put down a marker for (= shown that he is committed to) next year as the best time to launch the new product.
 3. (*BrE* also **'marker pen**) a pen with a thick **↑felt** tip
 4. (*BrE*) (*NAme grader*) a person who marks/grades students' work or exam papers
 5. (*BrE*) (in team games, especially football (**↑soccer**)) a player who stays close to a player on the other team in order to stop them getting the ball

marker of/for

 - the use of slang as a marker of social identity
3. (also **marker pen** *British English*) a large pen with a thick point made of **↑felt**, used for marking or drawing things ⇒ **↑Magic Marker**
4. **put/lay/set down a marker** *British English* to say or do something that clearly shows what you will do in the future
