Highway, freeway, interstate or turnpike? **Highway** is the most general of these terms and can mean any main road connecting and going through cities in the US. A **turnpike** is road that you have to pay to use. An **interstate** is a road with two or more lanes of traffic in either direction. This is called a **freeway** in the Western States. The same road may be referred to in different ways in different parts of the country.
