Word Origin:

late Middle English: from Latin, literally something to be brought to mind, gerund of *memorare*. The original use was as an adjective, placed at the head of a record made for future reference.

- The memorandum was dated 23 August, 2001.
- a memorandum directing that the Army take action
- a memorandum from the Attorney General to the President
- your memorandum of 18 February, 2001
