  - a sunny day
  - sunny weather

- cheerful and happy
  - a sunny disposition

**THESAURUS**

- sunny** if the weather is sunny, the sun is shining: When we arrived in Hong Kong, it was warm and sunny. | a lovely sunny afternoon
- fine** *especially British English* not raining, and with no clouds or only a few clouds in the sky: a period of fine weather | Next week will be fine but a little cooler.
- nice** (*also lovely especially British English*) **spoken** pleasantly warm and sunny: I t'ə lovely day – why don't we go for a walk? | I if's nice, we'll go to the beach.
- bright** if the weather is bright, the sun is shining and there is plenty of light: a bright sunny morning | I was bright earlier on in the day.
- beautiful/glorious** used when the weather is very good and there is a lot of sunshine: a glorious autumn day | The weather has been beautiful all week.
- clear** with no clouds or mist: I was a clear June morning. | a clear blue sky
- cloudless** *especially literary* with no clouds: The sun shone from a cloudless sky. | I was a beautiful cloudless morning.
- dry** with no rain: a period of dry weather | Tomorrow will be mostly dry.
