  - According to the police, his attackers beat him with a blunt instrument.
  - There is now widespread support for these proposals, according to a recent public opinion poll.
  - ▶ Do not say 'according to me' or 'according to my opinion/point of view'. Say **in my opinion**: *In my opinion his first book is much better.*
- in a way that depends on differences in situations or amounts:
  - You will be paid according to the amount of work you do.
- in a way that agrees with a system or plan, or obeys a set of rules:
  - The game will be played according to rules laid down for the 1992 Cup.
  - Everything went according to plan, and we arrived on time.
