2. **my goodness/my God etc** used when you are surprised or shocked about something:

" Oh my God! I've missed the train.

3. **my dear/darling/love etc** used when talking or writing to someone that you love or like a lot:

" Happy Birthday, my love.

II. my<sup>2</sup> BrE <sup>ˈ</sup> AmE <sup>ˈ</sup> interjectionused when you are surprised, <sup>↑</sup>impressed, or upset:

" My! Look at the size of that tree!
