▪ **I. rub-ber** [**rubber rubbers**] BrE [ˈrʌbə(r)] ^ˈ NAmE [ˈrʌbər] ^ˈ noun

1. uncountable a strong substance that can be stretched and does not allow liquids to pass through it, used for making tyres, boots, etc. It is made from the liquid (= ↑sap) inside a tropical plant or is produced using chemicals

- a ball made of rubber
- a rubber tree

2. countable (BrE) (also **eraser** NAmE, BrE) a small piece of rubber or a similar substance, used for removing pencil marks from paper, a piece of soft material used for removing ↑chalk marks from a ↑blackboard

4. countable (in some card games or sports) a competition consisting of a series of games or matches between the same teams or players
