- The novel **explores** ▪ the theme of friendship among homeless people.
- The first chapter **examines** ▪ the relationship between homelessness and drug addiction.
- The paper **considers** ▪ the question of why so many young people become homeless.

- The opening chapter gives a brief historical overview of the subject.
- The seminar aims to provide an overview on new media publishing.

- **a brief/quick overview** It is useful to give a brief overview of the research done so far.
- **a broad/general overview** (=concerning the main ideas or parts rather than all the details) This chapter gives a broad overview of accounting practices in the UK.
- **a comprehensive/complete overview** (=including all the details and important points) a comprehensive overview of the nuclear energy programme
- **a detailed overview** (=with a lot of information) a detailed overview of current legislation on gun control
- **a historical overview** The book gives a historical overview of the revolution.
