manpower distribution - *воен.* распределение личного состава

- a need for **trained/skilled manpower**
- a manpower shortage
- We have undertaken a major review to ensure best use of the available manpower.

Example Bank:

- Manpower will be reduced by an average of 20%.
- The factory's opening hours over the holiday period will depend on the availability of manpower.
- They did not have the manpower to comply with every regulation.
- a pool of manpower for the new industries
- a reduction in manpower
- a shortage of skilled manpower
- The crew was reduced to three due to a manpower shortage.
- We need to ensure best use of the available manpower.
