to manifest dissatisfaction - проявлять /выказывать/ неудовольствие
is impatience manifested itself in his expression - на его лице было написано нетерпение
to manifest a desire to do smth. - проявлять желание делать что-л.
he manifested a desire to leave - он изъявил желание уйти
the tendency manifested itself in ... - эта тенденция проявилась в ...
Chaucer's early poems manifest clearly the influence of French poets - в ранних стихах Чосера ясно видно /со всей очевидностью проступает/ влияние французских поэтов

2. **manifest itself** to appear or to become easy to see:

" His illness began to manifest itself at around this time.

[Date: 1300-1400; Language: Latin; Origin: **manifestus** 'seized by the hand']

plain and easy to see **SYN obvious, patent**:

" a manifest error of judgment

be made/become manifest (=be clearly shown)

" Their devotion to God is made manifest in ritual prayer.

—manifestly *adverb*:

" a manifestly unfair system
