2. **me too** *spoken* used to tell someone that you feel the same way as they do, that you are in a similar situation etc:
  - “ 'I'm hungry!' 'Me too.'
3. **me neither** (also **nor me**) *spoken* used to say that you agree with a negative statement that someone has just made:
  - “ 'I can't believe he's fifty.' 'Me neither.'
4. **me time** *informal* time when you can relax or do things that you enjoy doing, usually on your own:
  - “ Recognize that your partner needs some me time.
