COLLOCATIONS■ **adjectives**

- a **firm handshake** (=holding and shaking someone's hand firmly) Stan greeted me with a firm handshake.
- a **hearty handshake** (=friendly and firm) The wedding guests exchanged jokes and hearty handshakes.
- a **limp handshake** (=weak – used to show disapproval) I don't trust a man with a limp handshake.

■ **verbs**

- **greet somebody with a handshake** He greeted all of his guests with a handshake and a glass of wine.
- **give somebody a handshake** She introduced herself and gave Annie a handshake.
- **exchange handshakes** The teams exchanged handshakes at the end of the game.
