Word Origin:

late Middle English: perhaps related to Dutch **krat** 'tailboard of a wagon', earlier 'box of a coach', of unknown origin.

- They stacked the crates in the corner of the yard.
- a company specializing in shipping crates
- a crate of oranges
- An old man was sitting on an upturned beer crate.
