Word Origin:
mid 16th cent. (referring to magistrates in ancient Rome who held censuses and supervised public morals): from Latin, from **censere** 'assess'.

to examine books, films, letters etc to remove anything that is considered offensive, morally harmful, or politically dangerous etc ⇒ **ensorship, ban**:
The information given to the press was carefully censored by the Ministry of Defence.
