1. 1) **укладывать, складывать**  
to stow clothes in a trunk - сложить одежду в сундук
- 2) **убирать**  
to stow the anchor [the sails] - мор. убирать якорь [паруса]
2. 1) **наполнять, набивать**  
to stow smth. full of smth. - наполнить/набить что-л. до отказа чем-л.  
to stow a trunk with clothes - набить сундук одеждой  
the house was stowed - театр был полон /набит до отказа/
- 2) **загружать, грузить; штивать (груз)**  
to stow the cargo - погрузить груз /товары/ (на судно)  
to stow the hold - укладывать груз в трюме  
to stow away from the boilers - не грузить близ котлов
- 3) **горн. закладывать выработку пустой породой**

**stow away** *phrasal verb*

to hide on a vehicle in order to travel secretly or without paying:

- A boy was caught trying to stow away on a plane.
