 - The trees are being bulldozed to make way for a new superstore.
 - The makeshift dwellings were bulldozed into the ground.
2. **intransitive, transitive** to force your way somewhere; to force sth somewhere
 - + **adv./prep.** Rooney bulldozed through to score.
 - ~ **sth + adv./prep.** They bulldozed the tax through Parliament.
 - He **bulldozed his way** to victory.
3. **transitive** ~ **sb (into doing sth)** to force sb to do sth
