- **port** *noun* [uncountable and countable] a place where ships can be loaded and unloaded: a busy port | We'll have to wait ashore while the ship is in port | The ferry was about to leave port.
- **harbour** *British English, harbor American English noun* [countable] an area of water next to the land which is protected by walls so that the water is calm, and is a place where ships can stay when they are not sailing: They sailed into Portsmouth Harbour | Tourist boats leave the harbour at Riva regularly. | the harbour wall
- **dock** [uncountable and countable] a place in a port where ships are loaded, unloaded, or repaired: A crowd was waiting at the dock to greet them | The ship was in dock for repairs.
- **pier** a structure built over and into the water so that boats can stop next to it or people can walk along it | The yacht was moored at a pier.
- **jetty** *noun* [countable] a wall or platform built out into the water used for getting on and off boats or a wooden jetty | The house has a private jetty.
- **mooring** *noun* [countable] a place where a ship or boat is fastened to the land or to the bottom of the sea: Tugs towed the boat away from mooring at White Bay.
- **marina** *noun* [countable] a harbour where people keep boats which are used for pleasure: They are building a new 220-berth marina. | The apartments have a private marina.
