- живой, энергичный; горячий, пылкий  
 spirited critique - смелая критика  
 spirited attack - энергичная атака  
 spirited conversation - оживлённый разговор  
 spirited discussion - горячий спор  
 spirited features - выразительные черты лица  
 spirited reply - задорный ответ  
 spirited translation - яркий перевод  
 to give a spirited performance - играть с подъёмом
- (-spirited) *как компонент сложных слов настроенный каким-л. образом*  
 high-spirited - пылкий, горячий  
 low-spirited - подавленный

- full of energy, determination or courage
- a spirited young woman
  - a spirited discussion
  - She put up a spirited defence in the final game.

- sweet-spirited/tough-spirited/rebellious-spirited etc** having a particular type of character  
 ⇒ ↑high-spirited, ↑low-spirited, ↑mean-spirited, ↑public-spirited
