the total amount of rain that falls in a particular area in a particular amount of time; an occasion when rain falls

- There has been below average rainfall this month.
- an average annual rainfall of 10 cm

Example Bank:

- The area has a high annual rainfall.
- There have been heavy rainfalls this month.
- We need a good rainfall to save the crops.
- We have an average annual rainfall of around 750 mm.
