- only before noun (of a meal or sb's ↑appetite) large; making you feel full
 - a hearty breakfast
 - to have a hearty appetite
- usually before noun showing that you feel strongly about sth
 - He nodded his head in hearty agreement.
 - Hearty congratulations to everyone involved
 - a hearty dislike of sth
