- Guerrilla groups have accepted the government's offer of amnesty and have begun demobilizing.

2. **countable, usually singular** a period of time during which people can admit to a crime or give up weapons without being punished

- 2 000 knives have been handed in during the month-long amnesty.

Word Origin:

late 16th cent.: via Latin from Greek **amnēstia** 'forgetfulness'.

Example Bank:

- The government granted an amnesty to all political prisoners.
- They announced a general amnesty for crimes committed during the war.
- the President's amnesty program for illegal aliens
