Word Origin:

mid 17th cent.: from French **thermomètre** or modern Latin **thermometrum**, from **↑thermo-** 'of heat' + **-metrum** 'measure'.

Example Bank:

- Check that the roast is cooked right through, using a meat thermometer.
- He stuck a thermometer in her mouth.
- If the thermometer reads 98.6°F, then you don't have a fever.
