a painting, usually a large one, done on a wall, sometimes on an outside wall of a building

### Word Origin:

late Middle English: from French, from Latin *muralis*, from *murus* 'wall'. The adjective was first used in mural crown; later (mid 16th cent.) the sense 'placed or executed on a wall' arose, reflected in the current noun use (dating from the early 20th cent.).
