- официальный орган печати; правительственный бюллетень, вестник; *особ.* один из трёх официальных правительственных бюллетеней (The London Gazette, The Edinburgh Gazette, The Belfast Gazette)
to be /to appear, to have one's name/ in the gazette - быть упомянутым в газете, попасть в газету, *особ.* быть объявленным несостоятельным должником
 - учм.* газета, ведомости
2. [gə'zet] *v* *обыкн. pass*
опубликовывать в официальном бюллетене
to be gazetted - *воен.* быть произведённым в какой-л. чин (о чём сообщается в официальном правительственном бюллетене)
to be gazetted out - *воен.* поместить в газете приказ об увольнении в отставку

Word Origin:

early 17th cent.: via French from Italian *gazetta*, originally Venetian *gazeta de la novità* 'a halfpennyworth of news' (because the news-sheet sold for a *gazeta*, a Venetian coin of small value).

- The institute publishes a gazette twice a year.
