Word Origin:

late 19th cent.: from ↑jack + ↑pot. The term was originally used in a form of poker, where the pool or pot accumulated until a player could open the bidding with two jacks or better.

Example Bank:

- The National Theatre hit the jackpot with its first musical, 'Guys and Dolls'.
- The company hopes to hit the jackpot with its new range of clothing.
- They scooped the jackpot in yesterday's lottery.
- a prize jackpot of £100 000
