"What are those boxes on the front lawn?" asks Penny.

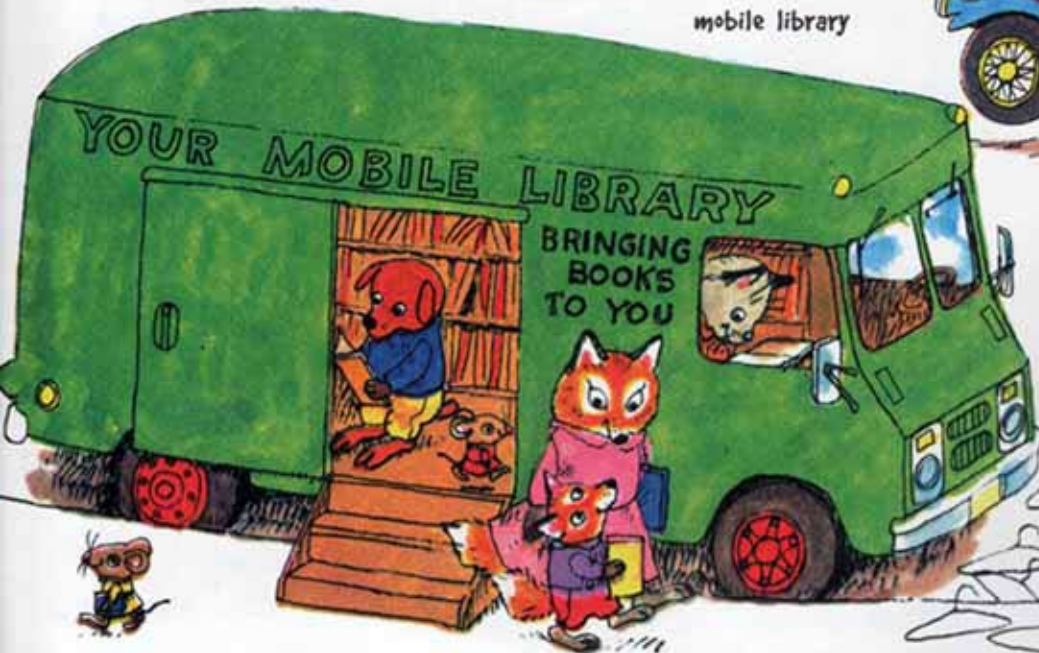
